



Conflict Resolution Agreement

Matthew 18:15-17 NLT

- 15. If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the fault. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back.**
- 16. But if you are unsuccessful, take one or two others with you and go back again, "so that everything you say may be confirmed by two or three witnesses". ***
- 17. If that person still refuses to listen, take your case to the church. If the church decides you are right, but the other person won't accept it, treat that person as a pagan or a corrupt tax collector. *Deuteronomy 19:15**

As a member of Networking In Christ I agree to follow the biblical model of Matthew 18:15-17 with respect to conflict within the group. This applies especially in matters of integrity, misrepresentation, broken trust, dishonesty etc.

1. When I feel a trespass has occurred, my first course of action will be to try to forgive and extend grace to the individual who has offended me. If I cannot I will go privately to the individual and point out the offense. I will do this in a humble and respectful manner.
2. If unsuccessful and I am not placated, I will talk the matter over with one or two others in the group and confront the individual again with them.
3. If the individual still won't repent of his/her sin, make amends and correct the trespass, I will take my issue before the leadership committee.
4. I understand that at this time, a unanimous vote of the Leadership committee may remove this person or me, if I am the offending party, from the group. If I am removed from this chapter by this procedure, I will not contest the decision of the leadership committee legally or by any other means.
